**2007-2008**

**Color Study: \$970**

**Sponsor: Tektronix**

This project will encourage students to think of color as a meaningful and useful element of art as they create their personal works. The two-part project will focus on the practical application of color using two diverse methods: working with glass and batik. The second project will involve hot and cold wax; dripped, brushed and cracked in combination with diluted acrylic paints onto cloth to form a "clothesline of color".

**2006-2007**

**Mountaineer Television: \$499**

Mountaineer Television is a student run and operated program in which students are responsible for reporting class, school and community events. Through this project students will learn, practice and apply basic principles of literacy in a real world setting.

**Fused Glass Water Feature: \$1,000**

Grant funds will be used to bring a glass artist to the school to present a lesson on the properties of glass and safety issues. Students will then explore novel and experimental methods of employing fused glass to create natural shapes, patterns and textures. These colorful shapes of fusible glass will be manipulated and melted, then used to embellish a concrete water feature in the school indoor courtyard.
