Birdhouse Stewardship: \$747

Funding Provided through Building STEAM 4 All Program

A birdhouse stewardship project will help students to develop an understanding of the relationship between math and science and how human actions can affect an ecosystem. Students will collect data on the birds in the local ecosystem and use the data to design, build and place birdhouses.
