BEF Middle School Extended Day Award: \$5,000

Seed the Change: Growing Community: \$1,000

Funding provided through Building STEAM 4 All Program

This project will encourage students to think of color as a meaningful and useful element of art as they create their personal works. The two-part project will focus on the practical application of color using two diverse methods: working with glass and batik. The second project will involve hot and cold wax; dripped, brushed and crackled in combination with diluted acrylic paints onto cloth to form a "clothesline of color".
