Extended Kindergarten: \$7,602.54

Grant funds will be used to continue this 2007 BEF Kids Count Grant after-school program for kindergarten students who have been determined to be at academic risk. The goal of the program is to supplement the teaching of literacy skills to enable children to meet grade level expectations by the end of kindergarten.

2006-2007

Extended Kindergarten: \$6,455.01

Research shows that children rarely catch up if they get off to a poor start in reading. The best time to give direct intensive instruction for academically at-risk children is in kindergarten. This after-school program is designed to prevent literacy problems through early detection and correction.
